A Children's Theatre of the Mesilla Valley, Inc. (ACT) is issuing a CALL FOR DIRECTORS for our upcoming season to be performed at the Rio Grande Theatre in Las Cruces, NM. We are looking for creative, talented directors who are interested in creating theatrical magic for young audiences working mainly with young actors (ages 5-18). Candidates should enjoy working with children.

Two performance slots are available, one in mid-December 2019 and one in April 2020. Rehearsals will be for at least 8 weeks 2-3 nights per week with 3 performances Friday and Saturday (Additional performances may be added depending on the nature of the show and ticket sales). ACT may elect not to fill a particular "performance" if an acceptable submission is not available.

Proposal Package

To be considered for a directing position, turn in a completed proposal package.

Your submission must include :

1 copy of your theatre resume (specifically in relation to directing experience. Please include references)

1 copy of a letter of introduction (please tell us why you are interested in directing a play at A Children's Theatre)

Additionally, if you are submitting a play that you are interested in directing:

1 detailed synopsis of the script

1 letter of interest (specifically, why you chose this play).

A Children's Theatre Executive Director will read the submissions and select the shows for the upcoming season. Please note, any plays submitted by members of ACT's Board of Directors or anyone currently affiliated with ACT will be given the same consideration as plays submitted by individuals not on the Board and not currently affiliated with ACT, and will be judged purely on merit.
